

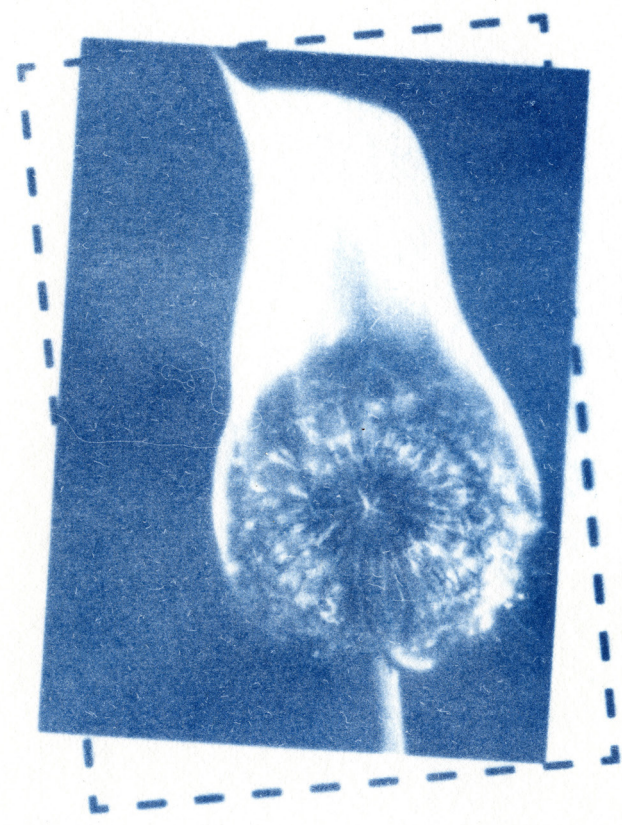

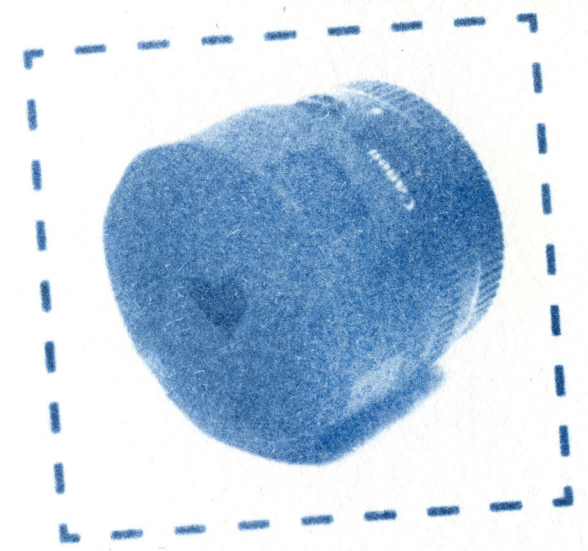

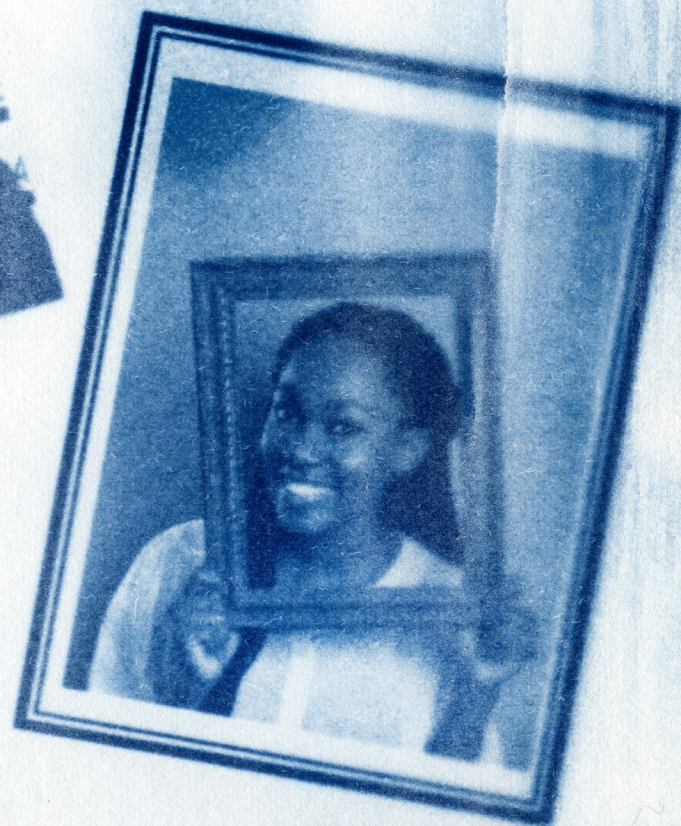
one of the more popular subjects to photograph is **Nature**, try thinking how you can manipulate classic shots to turn them into something **new**.



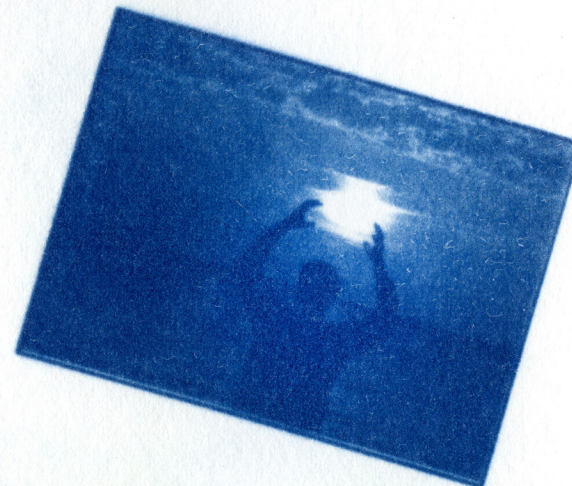
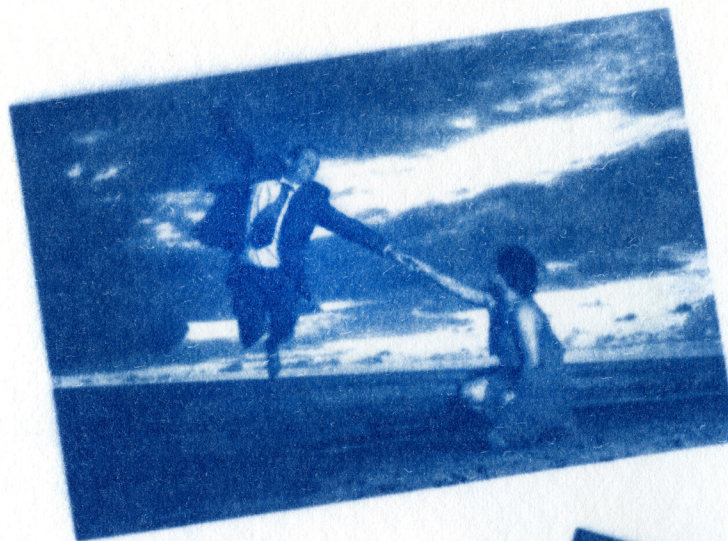
everybody loves **broken**, but did you know you can alter the shape of your broken with just some cardboard and tape?

Don't forget to keep your subjects awake and moving! have them jump around and interact with what's in frame.

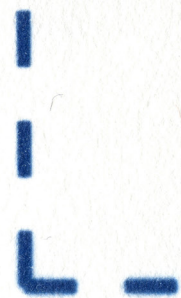
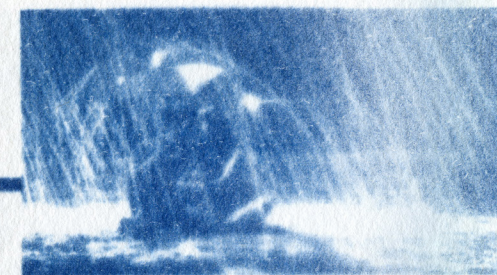
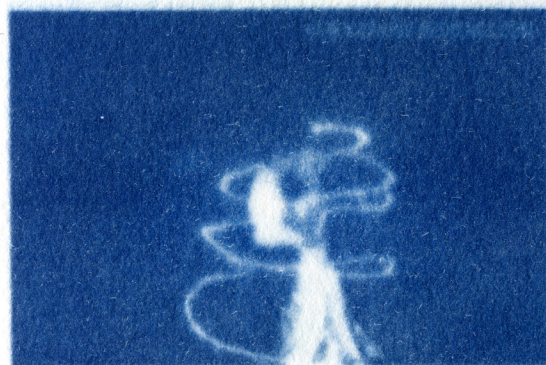
